Opening Hours

Periods	Opening hours
From April 1 to August 31	9:30 ~ 18:00
From September 1 to October 31	9:30 ~ 17:00
From November 1 to the last day of February	9:30 ~ 16:30
From March 1 to March 31	9:30 ~ 17:00

- Opening hours are subject to change due to events and other special circumstances. Please check in advance.
- Last admission is one hour before closing. (It is one hour and a half before closing for visitors with combined tickets.)

Closed on December 31, January 1, and the first Monday and Tuesday of February

Admission Fees

Ticket type	Individual	Group (with more than 20 people)
Adults (aged 15 to 64)	410 yen	290 yen
Children (in elementary and junior high school)	80 yen	50 yen
Senior citizens (aged 65 and over)	210 yen	210 yen

- Admission is free for children under 6 years old.
- Admission to Akashi Kaikyo National Government Park is free for holders of a physical disability certificate, a mental disability certificate, or a rehabilitation certificate.
- Admission tickets allow re-entry on the same day.
- Those with ticket stubs from either Awaji or Kobe (Aina Satoyama Park) Area of Akashi Kaikyo National Government Park can enter the other area on the same day.
- Please keep your ticket stub for re-entry.
- Combined tickets for Kiseki no Hoshi Botanical Museum and Akashi Kaikyo National Government Park are available.
- Annual tickets are also available.
- One-year ticket: ¥4,100 for adults, ¥800 for children, and ¥2,100 for senior citizens
